Sub: Post Facto Extension of approval for the academic year 2013-14.

Sir/Madam,

Based on the complaint received against Hi-Tech Institute of Technology, Aurangabad, the matter was processed and the approval granted to the Institute was withdrawn by AICTE vide letter dated 18.06.12. The Institute had approached the Hon'ble court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad, against the above withdrawal order. The Hon'ble Court in its order dated 16.07.2013 in W.P. No. 5106/2013 had directed to grant approval to the Institute for the relevant academic years. The Court order was put up before One Man Justice (Retd.) P. C. Jain Committee who had opined either to file SLP against the Court order or to comply with the court order. The AICTE had filed SLP in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter. The Hon'ble Court in Civil Appeal Nos. 8840-8842 of 2014 (Arising out of SLP (C) Nos. 4896-4898 of 2013) had inter alia passed the following order dated 09.09.2014:-

"Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we direct that as far as the first issue is concerned, the AICTE would be at liberty to inspect the premises within a period of three months to find out whether there has been appropriate barrier free access. If it has still not been provided, the institution shall do the needful to the satisfaction of AICTE.

As far as the second contention raised by Mr. Ramachandran is concerned, the same need not be adverted to in this case because the institution by virtue of the order passed by the High Court has already been given approval and it is presently functional. The issue of law in that regard is kept open."

The appeal is accordingly disposed of without any order as to costs."

The above order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India was placed before one Man Justice (Retd) P. C. Jain Committee on 12.11.2014. The Committee had finally recommended that the order dated 16.07.2013 of the Hon'ble Court be implemented fully.

In compliance to the above, the Council have decided to grant extension of approval to Hi-Tech Institute of Technology, Aurangabad for the academic year 2013-14. The decision was also ratified by the EC meeting dated 19.01.2015 vide agenda No. 90.02.05.

Therefore, in terms of the provisions under the All India Council for Technical Education (Grant of Approvals for Technical Institution) Regulations 2012 notified by the Council vide notification number-No.37/Legal/2012 dated 27/09/2012 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time, I am directed to convey the post facto extension of approval to

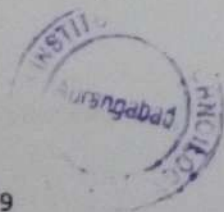
